Jessica Pratt sparkles in Bellini



Australian expatriate soprano Jessica Pratt returned to Melbourne last week in a memorable performance of Bellini's final opera, I Puritani. The cast for this Victorian Opera production at Hamer Hall had to rely totally on their voices to reveal their respective situations. Pratt's Elvira was an exemplar of extravagant bel canto delivery. The beauty of her performance and almost insouciant ease of her upper register, as she floated and expanded notes with an exceptional range of colours, left her capacity audience ecstatic. She was supported by a gifted Tenerife-born tenor, Celso Andres Albelo Hernandez, pictured with her above, as her betrothed, Lord Arturo Talbot, whose top notes had the audience screaming or more. Nathan Lay's Sir Ricardo Forth. the unsuccessful and embittered suitor for Elvira's hand, was handsomely delivered. Jeremy Kleeman and Paul Whelan offered strong vocal characterisations as the Governor-General and his brother. The impressive 33-strong chorus and Orchestra Victoria, under Richard Mills's meticulous direction, provided outstanding

Genisys is not a sequel to the most recent Terminator film but a recapitulation of the first two. Arnie has all the best lines, but there's an appealing humour in Courtney's performance. It's probably beyond the point of calling him a rising star but he sure has the look of our next big thing. The result is a superior action thriller that has the significant benefit of not taking itself too seriously. It's the finest Terminator since the first two.

Mother Courage and Her Children

Robyn Nevin's brittle and brilliant Mother Courage is lively and often very funny, but underneath there is the worldweariness of a woman who has been following armies in a long war, making a parasitic living off them and in the process losing all her children. Nevin's performance is magnificent. Each moment of sudden grief is briefly and movingly reflected in Nevin's lined face, and each ensuing moment of resilience is tragic. In this tightly urgent translation by Michael Gow, superbly directed by Eamon Flack, not a moment of this great play is neglected. This is a very fine production that ought to do a lot to correct the mistaken impression that Brecht, for all his seriousness, is not also not also provocative

The Nicholson Museum offers one of the most appealing museum experiences in Sydney, densely packed like an Ali Baba's cave of treasures, and including several small exhibitions on the Etruscans, the archeology of Cyprus, and even a highly entertaining and informative, if not very accurate, Lego Pompeii. Death Magic is devoted to ancient Egypt. Natural history items are juxtaposed with antiquities; thus a mummified head with a brain in formaldehyde and hook remind us how the brain was rather gruesomely removed before embalming.

The cast of Pinchgut Opera's Bajazet successfully balances dramatic intensity with flamboyant virtuosity Dark and brutal tale

Bajazet by Vivaldi Pinchgut Opera. City Recital Hall, Sydney. July 4.

Historians estimate that the wars unleashed by the emperor Timur (also known as Tamerlane) in the late 14th century killed 17 million people. His brutality and military brilliance aroused fear and admiration across Europe and Asia.

One of his victories was over the Ottoman Empire's Sultan Bayezid at the Battle of Ankara in 1402. This story inspired a flood of plays and operas in the 18th century, including Vivaldi's 1735 opera on the subject.

Bajazet is a dark and brutal tale of desire, ambition and betraval. Affairs of love and state intersect

as characters plot and scheme their way through an emotional and political maelstrom.

Vivaldi brings out the best in Pinchgut, Baiazet rivals the company's 2011 staging of that composer's Griselda for the mantle of Pinchgut's finest production.

Director Thomas de Mallet Burgess has updated the setting to the fin de siecle. It works, for this was another era when empires and kingdoms were carved up through a series of wars. characters prowled

around a wrecked drawing room which was gradually tidied up as Tamerlano's authority was imposed. The constant spectre of death was evoked by the bloodred-curtained backdrop and several skeletons menacingly looming over the stage

Showing a touch of brilliance, Burgess cleverly subverted the opera's unconvincing happy end-

ing in a manner true to both Tamerlano's character and the context of his production.

As with Griselda, the cast of Bajazet all shone in their respective roles by successfully balancing the need to achieve dramatic intensity while simultaneously displaying flamboyant virtuosity.

Baritone Hadleigh Adams cut a dignified figure as the defeated Bajazet. He astutely infused his resounding, dark-hued timbre with nuanced dynamics and tone colours to convey his character's emotional distress.

American countertenor Christopher Lowrey was spectacular as Tamerlano. Secure and assured across his mellow, subtly coloured tessitura, he effortlessly executed both rapid-fire pyrotechnics and sinuous longer lines. By contrast, fellow countertenor Russell Harcourt (Andronico) sang with penetrating, glintedged clarity. As Asteria, firmvoiced mezzosoprano Emily Edmonds shrewdly balanced expressive intensity with beauty of sound. Fellow mezzosoprano Helen Sherman (Irene) displayed a richly coloured timbre and thrilling agility. Soprano Sara Macliver (Idaspe) impressed with her pure-toned beauty and sense Conductor Erin Helyard and

the Orchestra of the Antipodes provided elegant, well-balanced accompaniments. Fast tempos, strong dynamic contrasts, forceful attack and incisive rhythmical drive generated energy and excitement while graceful phrasing and gleaming sonorities illuminated the composer's lyrical passages.

South of Wollongong, life has gone to the dogs

The Dapto Chaser By Mary Rachel Brown. Griffin Independent, Sydney, July 3.

Greyhound racing is a good way of going to the dogs, at least for Errol Sinclair, an old man who has spent his shonky life in the business and is now dving of cancer, still dreaming, still defiant and still poor. This traditional family drama is about dreams of gambling riches and the cycles of poverty that sustain them and are sustained by them.

Dapto is a small town south of Wollongong in NSW and the races are part of its culture. Mary Rachel Brown's play vividly evokes the world of the kennels, the track and the bookmakers. The dogs chase the lure and the people chase the money, both without success.

Brown's script is full of humour and anguish. It is directed by Glynn Nicholas, who has a sure touch with the comedy, and it has a good cast adept at finding the moments where hope turns to despair and then back again

Danny Adcock is the irascible old Errol, still obsessed with the business to the exclusion of any

real support for his sons. One of them is Jimmy, full of resentment and self-doubt about having been trapped in this dysfunctional family for so long. Jamie Oxenbould manages to find the inner strength of this very put-upon character.

The other son is Cess, the only character who actually seems to like the dogs themselves, or at least his own one, which is set, he believes, to become a champion. Richard Sydenham plays his passion and determination with an oldfashioned kind of ocker sensitivity.

Then there is the villain of the piece, Arnold Denny (Noel Hodda), an oily small-town rich man who has taken over the track and whose crass nastiness would be appalling to watch if it weren't so pathetic.

There is little sense of a community here. No one has any support, not even within the family, except for a few isolated moments. The only women in the story — the long-dead mother of the entrapped boys and Denny's young trophy wife – don't appear. The play is incredibly blokey. Perhaps the world of greyhound racing is too.
